

ECB Scorer Pathway: S4 Recreational Game Scorer Skills, Knowledge and Competencies



Planning & Preparation (up to and arriving at the game).

- Checks their equipment prior to match day
- Dressed casually and comfortably, but appropriate for match and environment
- Arrives at an appropriate time and sets up ready for the toss
- Meets and has discussions with stakeholders to ensure everything is in place for the game
- Gained Scorer privileges on Play-Cricket
- Knows the competition regulations related to scoring and records appropriately
- Downloads the match prior to arrival at the game, if appropriate
- Ensures the electronic scoring software is up to date
- Has access to relevant competition regulations

Scoring Technique & Scorebox Etiquette.

- Can identify own team members and recognise differences between players
- Has clear, established scoring routine including regularly checking own recordings
- Is aware of distractions but remains focussed on the match
- Records all interruptions in play accurately
- Awareness of scoring process for disallowed leg byes
- Records correct names of batters, regardless of whether they bat or not
- Knows when the winning run is scored
- Understands, and can record accurately, the difference between Not Out/Did Not Bat/Absent
- Can identify and qualify the result
- Can finish off the game correctly, including the completion of any missing data
- Can use Duckworth Lewis-Stern as required for your match
- Understands how to record penalty runs
- Understands the impact of player suspension and how to record accurately
- Can score matches using Play-Cricket Scorer Pro basic package and Play-Cricket Scorer App advanced levels.

People & Match Management.

- Interacts, appropriately, with players, coaches and spectators
- Seeks relevant and appropriate help when things go wrong
- Can show neutrality when part of the Officiating Team
- Understands timings and how this can impact the game (when does an innings start/stop)

Teamwork.

- Agree roles and responsibilities with scoring colleague
- Shows flexibility in routine when working with colleagues
- Checks scores regularly, at appropriate intervals, with colleagues
- Ensure the result is on Play Cricket and result is notified to the appropriate people
- Agrees communication methods with umpires during the game and uses radios at appropriate levels
- Expects and understands umpiring pre-signals.
